# Change advisory notice 300 – IUF LGA renamed to Merri-bek

## What is happening

From the delivery of the IUF seed on 02 July 2023, the Local Government Authority (LGA) Moreland will be renamed to Merri-bek.

#### Why this change is occurring

The Victorian Governor in Council officially approved the new name for Moreland City Council, with the change to Merri-bek published in the Victorian Government Gazette today (15 September 2022).

The new name, Merri-bek City Council, came into effect Monday, 26 September 2022.

This change to the IUF seed is consistent with previous Merri-bek name changes to Vicmap data, such as in the VMADMIN.LGA\_POLYGON table. The recent seed supply has enabled the Department to rename the council in the IUF deliveries.

#### Who will it affect

This change will affect any user of the Incremental Update Format (IUF) customers who process this file on a weekly basis.

The format of the data contained in the supplies has not changed, only the filenames and headers as described below.

### When the change will occur

Changes have been adjusted to reflect the new name on our SFTP server in the recent IUF Seed (02-July-2023) and the first incremental supply (09-July-2023). All subsequent incremental supplies will use the new name.
