



Bendigo Airport Airside Requirements

A Visitor Identification Card (VIC) or Aviation Security Identification Card (ASIC) must be displayed by users at all times when airside at the Bendigo Airport.

If you do not hold a valid ASIC you must apply for a VIC.

The surveying equipment located at the Bendigo Airport is within the airside boundary and all surveyors attending the site will need to comply with these rules.

To apply for a VIC please pre-register your attendance to ensure that we don't add any delays to your visit. You can pre-register your visit by following the links on our website or scanning the QR code below.

Please note that pre-registering does not guarantee the issuing of a VIC. There are certain requirements that need to be met to allow these to be issued. We will contact you in advance if we notice any issues that may prevent your issuing of a VIC. To collect your VIC, you will need to go to the Bendigo Airport Terminal. Please ensure you have photo identification with you when you attend. The building is not always open however if we know you are coming, we will be close by. Please call airport staff on 0499 700 128 if you can't locate them. Once your VIC is issued you will be given a quick induction and a pass code to gain access to the airside area.
