Electronic Conveyancing Release 2.0 commences

Release 2.0 of the Electronic Conveyancing (EC) System commenced on 16 November 2007.

It builds on the successful deployment of *Release 1.0* of the EC System launched 21 August 2006.

EC Release 2.0 allows electronic financial property settlement, the lodgement of land transfers, mortgages and discharges of mortgage and withdrawal of caveats (not stand alone) into Land Victoria, and electronic payment of duty to the State Revenue Office.

Subscription requirements

Any organisation may become an EC System Subscriber and use the EC System provided they meet eligibility criteria specified in the *EC System Rules* and the *Registrar's Requirements* (available online at www.landexchange.vic.gov.au/ec/legal_framework/index.html)

Minimum requirements to become a Subscriber are:

- an Australian Business Number
- a Victorian Online Titles System Customer Code
- insurance (as stated in the *Registrar's Requirements*).

For a property transaction to be processed through the EC System, all parties must be EC System Subscribers. Subscribers will require consent from their clients to process a transaction through the EC System.

The existing paper-based conveyancing system will continue to operate alongside the EC System.
